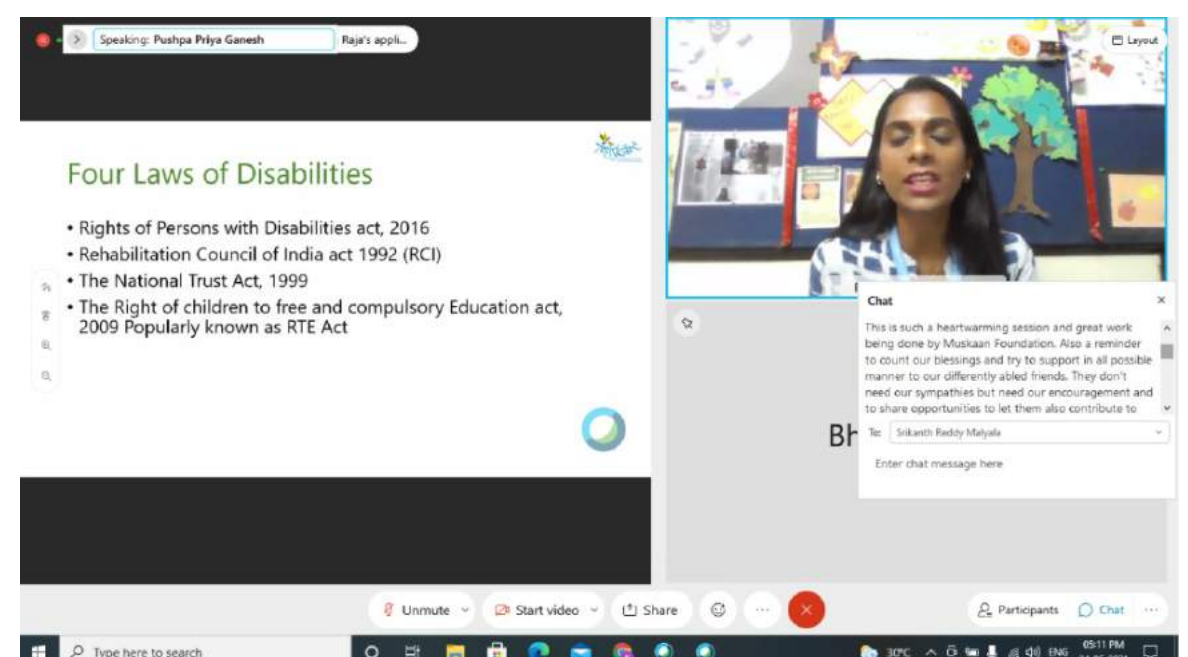

Celebrating Helen Keller Day

Muskan Foundation celebrated conquering disabilities on Helen Keller day with State Street Corporation. We conducted a presentation intended to share the incredible story of Helen Keller, an American Activist & Author who was the first deafblind person to earn a bachelor's degree in the US. Through Helen Keller's story we wanted to raise awareness about challenges faced by children with deafblindness and four laws for person with disabilities in India. We are very proud of our Special Educators Bhavika and Bhavana who sensitized the employees of StateStreet towards the Assistive communication systems used by persons with deafblindness ie Sign language, Braille, Orientation and Mobility techniques. We were amazed with the response & appreciation we received from the StateStreet Employees.



In House Training Program for Special Educators



For our In-House Training Program for Special Educators we invited Mr. Abhimanyu Kaul, Founder- Managing Director of Values In Action Corporation to impart understanding of Value Education and it's in-depth implementation in our daily life. The training was conducted through a module of 5 session wherein our Special Educators, Para-Professionals and Administrative staff of Muskan Foundation participated actively. His sessions on Value Education helped us to understand the true meaning and implications of unity in diversity. Through various examples of daily life, he explained the importance of ceiling on desires with respect to our inner self. From the values of self to the values of Muskan Foundation, Mr. Abhimanyu inculcated the importance of having a vision & mission in every individual's life and encouraged each participant to share their personal vision. With this session, the In-House Training for Teacher ends on a great note and we are looking forward to start our new academic year from 15 June, 2021.

Helping to get in touch with the spiritual self

During this In-House training, we taught our teachers different teaching strategies through various talks by experts. We are a combination of matter and spirit. 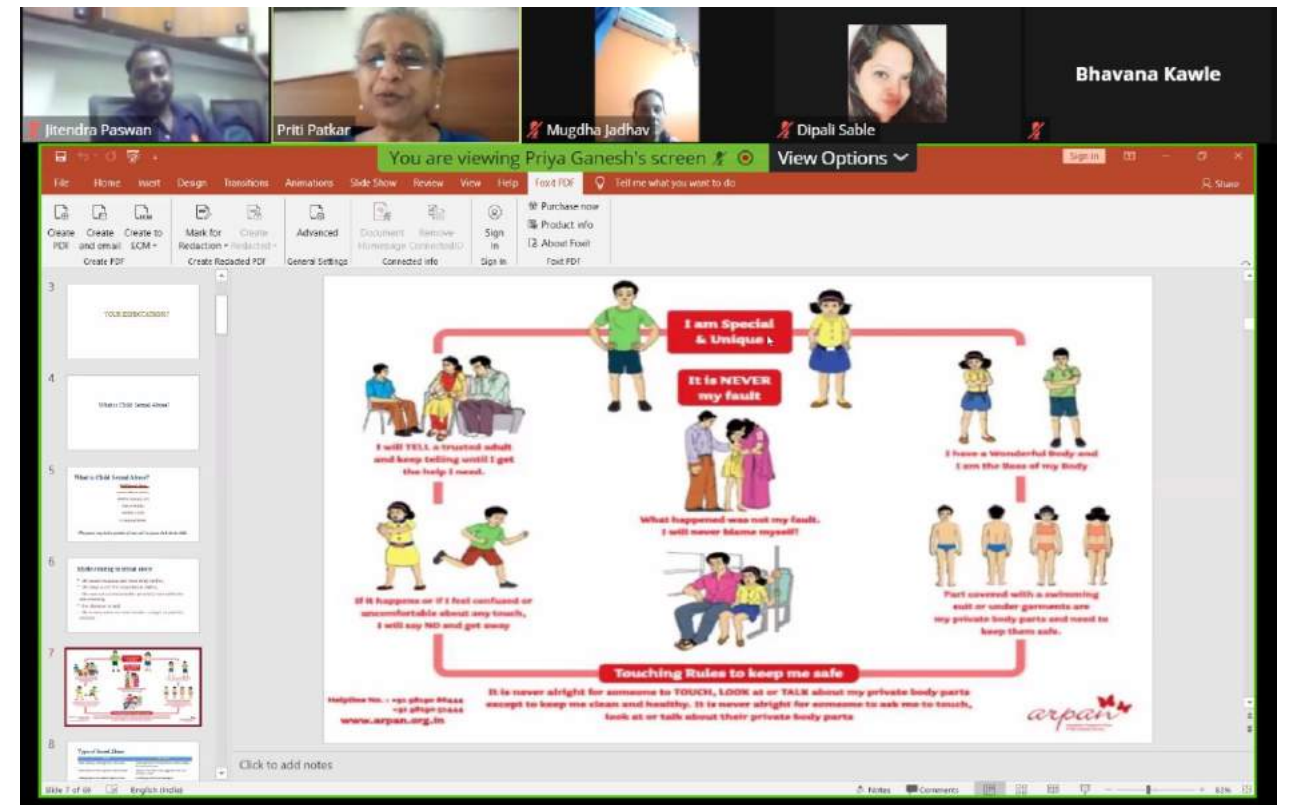


International Yoga Day

Knowledge Enhancement

In Muskan Foundation, protection and wellbeing of our children is of utmost priority. We invited Ms. Priti Patkar, co-founder of Prerna Foundation to shed light on “Child Sexual Abuse: Understanding POSCO 2012 and POSCO Rules 2020”. The session was highly informative wherein Ms. Priti explained important sensitive issues like sexual abuse in an empathetic manner. She explained the importance of instilling in all children the difference between safe & unsafe touch and to listen empathetically when a child opens up about any experience. We gained various inputs such as understanding different types of sexual abuse, creating a safety plan for each child and steps undertaken by an organization when dealing with a case of sexual abuse. We look forward to updating these inputs in our Child Protection Policy and thank Ms. Priti Patkar for an enriching, enlightening and engaging session.
