
At Muskan Foundation, we have a Mother Toddler Program, wherein the child with special needs and the mother are given focus, planned with joyous interventions.

Home Based Program -This program will be available children staying within city limits enabling the special educator/therapist to conduct regular home visits and provide various therapies and special education required for the child. The therapist/special educator will make one or two visits per week. The parents will be trained and guidance provided based on the of the child. needs The will therapist/special educator program plan and suggest a activities until the next visit to the parents.
